Festival of Harvest

It may not look like that now, but the Feast of Firstfruits, or Pentecost as it's called in the New Testament, has a meaning that transcends.

The Festival of Harvest (also called Weeks, Pentecost, or Shavout) is one of the three commanded festivals of Yahweh during which all men are commanded to.

This important feast gets its name from the fact that it starts seven full weeks, or exactly 50 days, after the Feast of Firstfruits. Since it takes place exactly 50 days.
